



CAMPING RULES & CONTRACT
WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE SERVICE TO ANYONE
CHECK OUT IS NOON

1. RV camping rates are \$28/day for power and/or water hookups, payable in advance. Garbage, restroom and dump station included. Please recycle. Two-week maximum stay unless permission is granted in office. We are a vacation destination and cannot offer long term camping.
2. Dry camping and tent camping is \$12/day, payable in advance. Restroom use included. Any use of power or water hookups must be cleared with camp host and will be charged. Three day maximum stay strictly enforced. Must be gone for a month before returning. Tent camping subject to restrictions during rain or wind.
3. One night maximum for sleeping in any vehicle not set up for camping.
4. Positively no recreational vehicles older than 15 years without written permission from Humboldt County Fair Association board of directors.
5. Camp vehicles and tents must be clean and serviceable. Tarps, duct tape, boarded windows, etc. are not permitted. Trailers not permitted without tow vehicle. RVs must be drivable. All vehicles must have current registration. All guests must complete registration card and will be asked to show identification.
6. Vehicles unattended & unpaid longer than three days will be towed. Contact Ferndale Police for tow information - 707-786-4025
7. Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. No generators, loud music, loud parties, excessive vehicle traffic, etc. Violators will be asked to vacate Fairgrounds immediately.
8. Fairgrounds will not tolerate noisy and/or violent domestic disturbances or any behavior that violates the tranquility of the park. Violators will be told to leave. Drug dealing will not be tolerated. Police will be informed and violators will be told to leave.
9. For non-campers, showers or use of lift station is \$5/use.
10. Rate allows two adults and four children 17 and under. Additional occupants must be reported to camp host. Additional occupants are \$3/day. Violation of this provision shall result in campers being told to leave the campgrounds. Fee for additional occupants must be paid in advance.

11. Campers will be assigned a campsite and a utility post. Camper or tent and one vehicle are permitted in each site. One additional tent may be permitted at the discretion of camp host or office and may be charged at a rate to be determined by camp host or office. Additional vehicles must be parked in parking lot and away from the fence. If an additional utility post is required, campers will be charged \$28/day. All camp equipment must be contained within the designated site.
12. Hookup to 220 power and water fill up is \$8/day extra per item.
13. Obtain office permission for package delivery. Positively do not use this address for mail.
14. Clutter, sprawl, laundry, etc. are not permitted at campsite. Waste water must be dumped at lift station. Camp chairs, camp table, camp light, cooler, etc. okay.
15. No ground fires. Portable fire pits are permitted. Cooled ashes must be collected in fire safe container and disposed of in dumpster. Do not dump ashes on the ground. Check with camp host before disposing.
16. Do not clean fish in campsite or dispose of waste in dumpster. Do not wash dishes, dogs, laundry in restrooms. Do not hang laundry at camp site. No major vehicle repairs. No washing vehicles.
17. Pets must be on leash. No aggressive or noisy dogs. We have several "Mutt Stations" on site so please clean up after your animal.
18. Children may not disturb other campers and must use extreme caution when riding bikes on fairgrounds. Horse barn is off limits to unsupervised children. Adult supervision is required at all times anywhere on fairgrounds.
19. Humboldt County Fair can accommodate most campers without reservations most of the year. However, some events, including August fair, severely restrict availability of camp sites. Organizations that rent fairgrounds including campground take priority over all other camp activities. Campers may be asked to leave the fairgrounds for some events.
