

FLORICULTURE GLOSSARY

ANNUAL - A plant that completes its outdoor cycle of growth in 1 year.

PERENNIAL - A plant that lives, blooms & seeds for more than 2 years. Trees & shrubs are hard wooded perennials.

SPIKE - A flower structure with flowers, stemless or very short stemmed, on a common lengthened stalk, i.e., Gladiolus.

SPRAY - Portion of a plant with a number of flowers on one stem. i.e. Petunia.

STEM - The main ascending part of a plant, i.e., Tea Rose, Carnation.

STALK - A stiff stem which may or may not branch, and with one or more flowers & buds, i.e., Bearded Iris.

BLOOM - Individual flowers, 1 blossom on a stem, i.e., Dahlia, Carnation, Rose.

SPECIMEN - A single plant, bloom, spike, spray, stalk or stem.
