

YOUTH & ADULT POULTRY

RULES & INFORMATION

- Birds must be clean and healthy. **Prior to coop-in at the Poultry Barn, exhibitors will report to a Poultry Health Inspection area where birds will be examined by a licensed inspector. Healthy birds will receive paperwork that will admit them to the Poultry Barn.** Call 786-9511 for information and location of the inspection site.
- **Exhibitors to provide water cups, feeders and directions for feeding. Water cups and feeders to accommodate bird for 24 hours.** No moldy feed accepted. Fair employees will feed adult entries only.
- Specify on entry form if double cages are needed. Specify breed & variety of bird as well as sex and color.
- Youth exhibitors, NOT parents, must groom and care for exhibits.
 1. Youth exhibitors must be present when market turkeys and meat birds are judged.
 2. Youth exhibitors must provide sturdy plastic or metal water cups (at least pint- sized for bantams and other small birds, at least quart-sized for large birds and at least ½ gallon-sized for turkeys and geese). All waterers must be able to be secured to cages.
 3. If cages are not kept clean and birds properly maintained premiums may be withheld.
- Poultry may be offered for sale after judging. Fair will retain a 20% commission on all sales. State Health Department regulations apply.
- 4-H & Independent exhibitors will be judged together. Exhibitors must be 5 years of age to show. Mini-4-H may show but may not be judged. They will receive participation ribbons.
- 4-H & FFA champion, reserve champion, and 3rd & 4th place chicken and turkey meat birds are eligible to sell at Junior Livestock Auction. All Junior Livestock Auction rules apply. **Youth must be at least 9 years of age Jan. 1 of auction year to sell at Auction.** See Livestock Auction Rules. Seller must attend auction orientation meeting Sat. Aug 26, at 9am in Covered Arena.
- Both youth and adult shows are APA & ABA sanctioned shows.
- 4-H & FFA poultry competition for static displays in Poultry Building.
- Small Animal Round Robin – Thurs, Aug 24, 7:00 pm in the Judging Pavilion.
