QUICK BANANA BREAD (½ loaf to be exhibited)

2 eggs	½ tsp salt
1 cup sugar	1 ½ cups flour
½ cup oil	½ cup chopped nuts
1 tsp vanilla	2 ripe bananas
½ tsp baking soda	

Blend eggs, sugar, oil & vanilla. Sift together flour, soda & salt. Add dry ingredients alternately with chunks of bananas & nuts. Blend with mixer. Bake in loaf pan at 325 degrees, 45-50 min. Test before removing

QUANTITIES: muffins, cupcakes-4; cookies, candy-6; cake- ¼ + 1" slice; 6" or larger pie, whole; bread-1/2 loaf. Use sturdy paper plates that won't bend.
