DIVISION 775 - MARKET BEEF - 4-H OR INDEPENDENT JUNIORS

Class 1 Heifers and Steers – Steers, 1,000 lbs. & over; heifers, 1000 lbs & over

DIVISION 776 - MARKET BEEF - FFA

Class 2 FFA Heifers and Steers – Steers, 1,000 lbs & over; heifers, 1000 lbs & over

MARKET BEEF SCORECARD

MARKET READY: Market steers projected to have sufficient fat deposition to meet the marbling specifications for USDA Prime, Choice or Select+ quality grades.

NOT MARKET READY: Market steers lacking evidence of sufficient fat deposition to produce a desirable consumer product. Steers projected to grade USDA Select- or lower.

These animals are not eligible for Junior Livestock Auction.

Auction maximum weight paid will be 1300 lbs.

DIVISION 777 - FEEDER SINGLE ANIMALS - Heifers & Steers - Only animals not meeting weight requirements of above 899 lbs. No pre-entries. 4-H, FFA and Independent together.

RULES

- Scales open for beef from 5-7pm. Animals will be weighed once.
- All animals must be without horns.
- Exhibitor must own animal for 120 consecutive days prior to Fair.
- If you use outside pens overnight, animals must be back in barn by 8 am. \$50 deposit for pen use.
- Animal must show in Market, Registered or Breeding divisions to enter Showmanship.

 - 3 Pair of Females Two females owned by exhibitor
 - 4 Aged Cow/Calf Pair Any cow, any age, calf at side

This division is limited to crossbred or unregistered females only. By his/her signature as owner/agent on the entry form the exhibitor certifies that the sire of each animal entered in this division was either purebred or registered. A permanent ear tag or tattoo number is required. Animals that have been registered by a purebred breed association cannot be entered in this division.

DIVISION 781 – BEEF BUCKET BABY – Entry fee \$1

Class 1 Bucket Calf For youth 8 years and under first day of fair. Need not own animal, but must be in their care for at least 60 days prior to fair. Calf no older than 4 months first day of fair. Grade or registered. All participants receive ribbon and special gift.
