DIVISION 775 – Market Beef – 4-H or Independent Juniors

Class 1 Heifers and Steers – Steers 1,000lbs and over; Heifers, 1000lbs & over

DIVISION 776 – Market Beef - FFA

Class 2 FFA Heifers and Steers – Steers 1,000lbs and over; Heifers, 1000lbs & over

Market Beef Scorecard

MARKET READY: Market steers projected to have sufficient fat deposition to meet the marbling specifications for USDA Prime, Choice or Select + quality grades.

NOT MARKET READY: Market steers lacking evidence of sufficient fat deposition to produce a desirable consumer product. Steers projected to grade USDA Select or lower.

Auction maximum weight paid will be 1300 lbs

DIVISION 777 – Feeder Single Animals – Heifers & Steers – Only animals not meeting weight requirements of above 1000 lbs. No pre-entries, 4-H & FFA and Independent together.

Rules

- Animals will be weighed once.
- All animals must be without horns
- Exhibitor must own animal for at least 120 consecutive days prior to Fair.
- If using overnight pens, animals must return to barn by 8am - \$50 deposit for pen use to be paid to livestock office.
- Animal must be entered in in market or breeding divisions to enter Showmanship.
