**By his/her signature as owner or agent on entry form the exhibitor certifies that the sire of each animal entered in the above classes for grade animals was registered.**

## **Rules**

- ❖ A permanent ear tag or tattoo number is required. Animals registered by a purebred breed association cannot be entered into this division.
- ❖ California cattle of all breeds must be from a herd that is not infected with tuberculosis or brucellosis. All dairy females over four months of age must bear evidence of official calfhood vaccination against brucellosis.
- ❖ Senior and junior yearlings in milk must be shown with two-year-olds in both the individual and group classes.

*Requirements for testing for bovine tuberculosis have been lifted by the Humboldt County Fair for all dairy animals. However, the Dairy Replacement Heifer Committee urges it for sale heifers. Please contact committee members for guidelines.*
