SHOWMANSHIP

1. Exhibitors with dairy goats may participate in the Dairy Doe Showmanship (Div. 431)
2. Exhibitors with Boer goats may participate in the Market Goat Showmanship (Div. 440)

RULES

1. Bucks and animals not entered in the show are not allowed on grounds.
2. Dairy Replacement Does and Market goats may not show in Divs. 441 & 442.
3. Exhibitors may enter up to 2 animals in each class of Divs. 441 & 442.
4. Animals must be owned by exhibitor for 60 consecutive days.
5. Animals must be registered and registration papers must show exhibitor's name.
6. Goats from scrapie non-compliant flocks or animals that are scrapie positive or scrapie suspects will not be accepted at the fair.
7. All goats require individual identification, whether registration papers with matching tattoos, APHIS ear tags, approved premises ID tattoos, flock certification ear tags or tattoos or other method approved by the CA Dept of Food & Agriculture. Contact USDA 877-741-3690 for additional information.
8. Exhibitors must groom and care for their own animals.
9. Animals will be housed at least two to a pen. Animals may not be housed with Dairy Replacement Does or Market Goats.

RULES

1. Each exhibitor may sell only one dairy doe. Selling this animal will not affect status in the Junior Livestock Auction. Exhibitor must be at least 9 years of age by Jan. 1, 2017, to sell at the auction.
2. **REGISTRATION AND STAR REQUIREMENTS:** Doe must be an American or Purebred, born not before Dec 1 of the year prior to the sale, and not after March 31 of the sale year. **Doelings must be by an ADGA recognized Star or Plus buck or out of a Star doe.**
3. The youth member will see that the doe is dehorned, permanently identified, CAE negative and vaccinated for clostridium. Goats from scrapie non-compliant flocks or animals that are scrapie positive or scrapie suspects will not be accepted at the fair.
4. Members must own does for at least 120 days prior to exhibiting at the Youth Dairy Goat Show at the Fair.
5. Project information form, project agreement form, seller's agreement/bill of sale form and a copy of the registration papers or registration application **must be mailed** to Humboldt Dairy Doe Replacement Project, , PO Box 1469, Ferndale CA 95536. and **must be postmarked by April 30. Forms will be accepted up until the CAE testing date with a \$25 late fee. Does without the above items will not sell.** Packets can be obtained at the Fair office or forms may be printed from the Project website: www.hddrp.org.
6. Project does must be entered and shown in the Humboldt County Fair in the division provided for auction does. Does will be housed two to a pen. No companion animals.
7. Does must be tattooed prior to CAE testing clinic.
8. CAE testing must be done through the committee's official testing clinic. One testing clinic will be provided, and does must be tested at this clinic to sell. Youth must arrange to get doelings to test site. All CAE tests will be sent to Washington State University by Ferndale Veterinary and test results will be sent to the committee. If any follow-up testing need be done, it will be done through the committee at Ferndale Veterinary, and a negative test result must be received prior to Youth Livestock check-in day. No does will be accepted in sale pens without a negative test result.
9. Original registration papers must be submitted to the committee at the exhibitors' meeting prior to Auction.
10. A 3.5% sale commission will be charged to defray the cost of promoting and conducting the auction.
11. A doe may be substituted prior to Fair entry, upon the discretion of the committee. Additional documentation may be required by the Dairy Doe Auction Committee as evidence for the substitution.
12. Mandatory exhibitory meeting Sat, Aug 26, 10 am.
13. Buyers shall pay the bank clerking the sale for their purchases immediately after the sale. Sellers must present a Thank You note and sign their papers prior to receiving their checks. Checks will not be available until after the sale.
