- * A permanent ear tag or tattoo number is required. Animals registered by a purebred breed association cannot be entered in this division.
- * California cattle of all breeds must be from a herd that is not infected with tuberculosis or brucellosis. All dairy females over four month of age must bear evidence of official calfhood vaccination against brucellosis.
- * Senior and junior yearlings in milk must be shown with two-year-olds in both the individual and group classes.
