Meat Pen Rules

- ❖ All applicable Youth Livestock Auction rules apply
- ❖ Meat pen competition judged by current ARBA rules
- ❖ Rabbits entered in Division 451 are limited to Humboldt County residents only.
- ❖ Meat pens consist of three rabbits 3lbs to 5lbs each and not over 70 days old. Animals to be the same breed and variety.
- ❖ Exhibitors must own animal for at least 30 consecutive days prior to Fair.
- ❖ Auction meat pens to be judged Wednesday, August 22 at Noon in the Rabbit Barn.
- ❖ Sale weight will be determined at time of judging.
- ❖ Seller to provide processing arrangements.
- ❖ 4H and independent exhibitors show together in Meat Pen division.
- ❖ Champion and Reserve Champion meat rabbits are eligible to sell at the Youth Livestock Auction. Eligible sellers must attend auction orientation meeting Saturday, August 26 at 9am in the Covered Arena.
- ❖ Exhibitor must be at least 9 years of age by Jan 1, 2018 to enter in Division 451.

DIVISION 452 – Showmanship (Rabbits must be entered in another division)

Class 1 Novice – 9 or 10 or 1st year of showing*

2 Junior – 11 and 12 years old*

3 Intermediate – 13 and 14 years old*

4 Senior – 15 years and older*

5 Mini – 5 to 8 years old*

*Age as of January 1, 2018

1st and 2nd place winners from Senior showmanship are eligible for Small Animal Round Robin on Saturday, August 25th at 4 pm in the Covered Arena
