DIVISION 441 – Registered Dairy Does – Non-sanctioned show

Class 1	Kids.....Born between 1/1/18 and 5/31/18
2	Dry Yearlings.....Born between 11/1/17 and 12/31/17
3	1 year to under 3-in milk.....Born between 1/1/15 and 12/31/17
4	3 years & up in milk.....Born before 1/1/16

DIVISION 442 – Boer Does – Non-sanctioned show

Class 1	Spring Doe Kids.....Born between 4/1/18 and 7/30/18
2	Winter Doe Kids.....Born between 1/1/18 and 3/31/18
3	Fall Doe Kids.....Born between 10/1/17 and 12/31/17
4	Does 24 months & under Never kidded.....Born between 6/1/16 and 9/30/17
5	Senior Does – any age – having kidded

Showmanship

- ❖ Exhibitors with dairy goats may participate in the Dairy Doe Showmanship Division 431
- ❖ Exhibitors with Boer goats may participate in the Market Goat Showmanship Division 440

DIVISION 431 – Dairy Goat Showmanship (Goat must be entered in another division)

Class 1	FFA – Novice
2	FFA
3	Novice – 9 or 10 or 1 st year of showing
4	Junior – 11 and 12 years old
5	Intermediate – 13 and 14 years old
6	Senior – 15 years and older

DIVISION 440 – Boer Goat Showmanship (Goat must be entered in another division)

Class 1	FFA – Novice
2	FFA
3	Novice – 9 or 10 or 1 st year of showing
4	Junior – 11 and 12 years old
5	Intermediate – 13 and 14 years old
6	Senior – 15 years and older

Rules

- ❖ Bucks and animals not entered in the show are not allowed on the fairgrounds
- ❖ Exhibitors may enter up to 2 animals in each class of Division 441 & 442
- ❖ Animals may be housed at least two to a pen. Animals may not be housed with Dairy Replacement Does or Market Goats.
- ❖ Dairy Replacement Does and Market goats may not show in Divisions 441 & 442.
- ❖ Exhibitors must own goat for 60 consecutive days prior to fair.
- ❖ Exhibitors must groom and care for their own animals.
- ❖ Animals must be registered and registration papers must show exhibitors name.
- ❖ All goats require individual identification: registration papers with matching tattoos, APHIS ear tags, approved premises ID tattoos, flock certification ear tags or tattoos or other method approved by the CA Department of Food and Agriculture. Phone USDA 877-741-3690 for certification and identification information.
- ❖ Goats from scrapie non-compliant flocks or animals that are scrapie positive or scrapie suspect will not be accepted at the Fair.
