MARKET GOAT SCORECARD

Market Ready USDA prime or choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .08-.12 most desirable, 13-.22 back fat acceptable, average or great conformation and cutability.

Not Market Ready Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range <.08 or >.22; underfinished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cutability.

RULES

1. Entry not valid without entry fee, bill of sale, signed seller's declaration, exhibitor, parent & leader signatures..
2. Animals may be housed two to a pen. No companion animals.
3. Exhibitor must own goat for 60 consecutive days prior to Fair.
4. Exhibitor must be at least 9 years of age by Jan 1, 2017, to sell at the auction.
5. All goats require individual identification: registration papers matching tattoos, APHIS ear tags, approved premises ID tattoos, flock certification ear tags or tattoos or other method approved by the CA Dept of Food & Agriculture. Phone USDA 877-741-3690 for certification and identification information. Identification must be present at weigh in.
6. Goats from scrapie non-compliant flocks or animals that are scrapie positive or scrapie suspects will not be accepted at the Fair.
7. Goats must show milk teeth. Goats must be under 1 year of age.
8. Goats may be dehorned. Horned goats must have horns tipped.
9. Goats must be slick shorn to 3/8", but not below knees and hocks.
10. Only wethers or does may show. Halters or chains are acceptable.

DIVISION 439 – FEEDER ANIMALS – Only animals that do not meet weight requirements of 55 pounds. No pre-entries. 4-H, FFA & Independent together.

DIVISION 432 – PYGMY GOATS & PET GOATS (Non-sanctioned show)

- Class 1** Pygmy doe kid (1 year & under*)
2 Pygmy doe adult (over 1 year and under 2*)
3 Pygmy doe adult (over 2 years*)
4 Pygmy wether kid (1 year & under*)
5 Pygmy wether adult (over 1 year and under 2*)
6 Pygmy wether adult (over 2 years and under 4 years*)
10 Pygmy wether adult (4 years* Pygmy wether adult (4 years and over) and over)
7 Best pygmy pair (any age, does or wethers)
8 Any crossbred pygmy
9 Any unregistered “pet” goat, purebred or crossbred. Not eligible for any other class. Must enter Showmanship division that most closely resembles goat type. Must show scrapies tag.

*Age day of show

RULES

- 1** No bucks. No companion animals.
- 2** Animal must be owned by exhibitor for 60 consecutive days.
- 3** Pygmies may be registered or not, but, if registered, papers must show exhibitor’s name.
- 4** Goats from scrapie non-compliant flocks or animals that are scrapie positive or scrapie suspects will not be accepted at the Fair.
- 5** All goats require individual identification, whether registration papers with matching tattoos, APHIS ear tags, approved premises ID tattoos, flock certification ear tags or tattoos or other method approved by the CA Dept of Food & Agriculture. Contact USDA 877-741-3690 for additional information.
- 6** Exhibitors must groom and care for their own animals.
- 7** Animals will be housed at least two to a pen. Exhibitors must bring materials to contain goats less than 1 year of age.
