YOUTH SWINE - MARKET

NOTE: Maximum swine weight 300 lbs. **Any swine over 280 pounds will be moved to the Heavyweight class and be eligible to sell at auction but will not be eligible to show in the champion drive.** Anything over 300 pounds will be excused from the market class but will allowed to participate in Showmanship. **Maximum auction weight paid will be 280lbs.**

Class 1 4-H or Independents - 200 -300lb

DIVISION 796

Class 2 FFA Market Swine - 200 - 300lb

MARKET HOGS SCORECARD

MARKET READY: U.S. No. 1 and No. 2 hogs of average or greater conformation that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits.

NOT MARKET READY: Any hog of below average conformation including U.S. No. 3, U.S. No. 4 and utility grade hogs.

DIVISION 797 - SINGLE FEEDER CLASS - No pre-entries. Only animals not meeting weight requirements of above 199 lbs. All divisions together.

RULES

- Each exhibitor should bring a short chain and combination lock to secure the animal in the pen.
- After weighing, hogs may be divided into weight lots for convenience in judging.
- Scales close at 7 pm.
- Animals will be weighed only once.

- **Must use a guard when clipping pigs before fair due to processing problems at harvest. Guidelines for trimming will be available at Fair.**
- Animals must be shown in Market or Breeding divisions to enter showmanship
