## **DIVISION 432 – Pygmy Goats & Pet Goats (Non-sanctioned show) \*Age day of show**

- Class 1    Pygmy doe kid – 1 year and under\*
- 2        Pygmy doe adult – over 1 year and under 2 years\*
- 3        Pygmy doe adult – over 2 years\*
- 4        Pygmy wether kid – 1 year and under\*
- 5        Pygmy wether adult – over 1 year and under 2 years\*
- 6        Pygmy wether adult – over 2 years and under 4 years\*
- 7        Best pygmy pair – any age – does or wethers
- 8        Any crossbred pygmy
- 9        Any unregistered “pet” goat, purebred or crossbred. Not eligible for any other class. Must enter Showmanship division that most closely Resembles goat type - must show scrapie tag.
- 10       Pygmy wether adult – 4 years\* Pygmy wether adult (4 years and over) and over)

### **Rules**

- ❖ No bucks and no companion animals.
- ❖ Animals may be housed at least two to a pen. Exhibitors must bring materials to contain goats less than 1 year of age.
- ❖ Animal must be owned by exhibitor for 60 consecutive days prior to fair.
- ❖ Pygmies may be registered or not, but, if registered, papers must show exhibitor’s name.

## Rules continued

- ❖ Goats from scrapie non-compliant flocks or animals that are scrapie positive or scrapie suspects will not be accepted at the Fair.
- ❖ All goats require individual identification, whether registration papers with matching tattoos, APHIS ear tags, approved premises ID tattoos, flock certification ear tags or tattoos or other method approved by the CA Department of Food and Agriculture. - ❖ Exhibitors must groom and care for their own animals.

### **DIVISION 435 – Pygmy Goat Showmanship** (Goat must be entered in Division 432, Classes 1-10)

Class 1	Novice – 9 or 10 years old or first year of showing
2	Junior – 11 and 12 years olds
3	Intermediate – 13 and 14 years old
4	Senior – 15 years and older

Winners are eligible for Small Animal Round Robin on Saturday, August 25 at 4pm in the Covered Arena.
